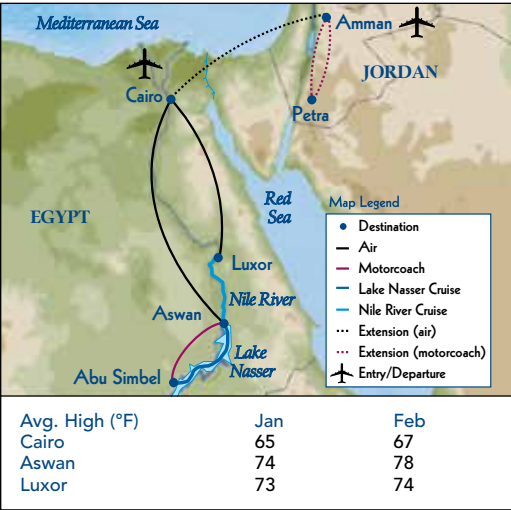

Egypt & the Eternal Nile

Accompanied by an expert Egyptian guide, this singular small group journey through antiquity travels from vibrant Cairo and the Great Pyramids to Abu Simbel and the Upper Nile for a fascinating cruise on Lake Nasser. Then: a classic voyage along the Lower Nile from Aswan to Luxor before returning to Cairo.



Day 1: Depart U.S. for Cairo, Egypt

Day 2: Arrive in Cairo We arrive in the Egyptian capital and transfer to our hotel. As guests' arrival times may vary greatly, we have no group activities or meals planned.

Day 3: Cairo After a morning briefing, we tour the exciting (and recently opened) Grand Egyptian Museum (GEM). The GEM's collection showcases over 700,000 years of Egyptian history. After our guided tour, we enjoy lunch and free time for further exploration of the museum on our own. Tonight we enjoy a welcome dinner at a local restaurant. *B,L,D*

Day 4: Cairo/Abu Simbel/Embark Lake Nasser Cruise Early this morning we fly south to Aswan then continue by coach across the edge of the Sahara to Abu Simbel. We board our Lake Nasser ship in time for lunch, then visit the temples and colossal 65-foot-high statues of Ramses II and his wife Nefertari that were dismantled and moved to higher ground during the construction of the Aswan Dam. Tonight we watch a dramatic sound-and-light show at Abu Simbel. *B,L,D*

Day 5: Lake Nasser Cruising – Kasr Ibrim/Amada/Wadi el-Seboua Early risers can watch the sun climb over the temples at Abu Simbel before we sail to Kasr Ibrim, the last remaining Nubian settlement in its original location. From the sun deck we learn about this ancient site (it's forbidden to go ashore here), then sail to Amada, followed by Wadi el-Seboua. *B,L,D*

Day 6: Lake Nasser Cruising – Wadi el-Seboua/Valley of the Lions/Aswan This morning we visit the striking avenue of sphinxes in Wadi el-Seboua's "Valley of the Lions" then cruise to Aswan. *B,L,D*

Day 7: Disembark/Aswan/Embark Nile Cruise Ship We set out early this morning to visit New Kalabsha, site of the largest freestanding Nubian temple, which was relocated here for the construction of the Aswan Dam. We return to our ship for breakfast then bid farewell to the crew as we embark on a tour of the Aswan High Dam. Next we visit the Temples of Philae on Agilkia Island before boarding our Nile cruise ship. *B,L,D*

Day 8: Nile Cruising – Kom Ombo/Edf This morning, we embark small *feluccas*, replicas of ancient Nile sailboats. After lunch, we sail to the ancient trading town of Kom Ombo, with outstanding Nile views from the Temple of Sobek. After returning to our ship, we sail on to Edfu where we dock for the night. This evening, we attend the Captain’s welcome cocktail party aboard our ship, wearing traditional Egyptian *galabeya*. *B,L,D*

Day 9: Nile Cruising – Edfu/East Bank This morning we explore Edfu’s Temple of Horus, Egypt’s best-preserved temple (built between 237 BCE–57 BCE). We return to our ship for lunch as we sail to tour Luxor’s East Bank, home of Karnak, the greatest temple complex of them all, whose ruins stretch for more than a mile to connect with Luxor. We also explore Luxor Temple, whose builders included both Tutankhamun and Alexander the Great. Here, at the Great Court of Ramses II, we see the ancient obelisk whose twin presides over Place de la Concorde in Paris. A traditional Middle Eastern belly dancing performance accompanies dinner on board tonight. *B,L,D*

Day 10: Disembark/Luxor/West Bank Known in antiquity as Thebes, Luxor boasts vast temple complexes, tombs, and statues dating from 2755 BCE that represent the pinnacle of Egyptian architecture. Today we explore the West Bank, site of the haunting Valley of the Kings, where 34 royal tombs feature magnificent paintings; the Valley of the Queens; and the Temple of Hatshepsut honoring one of the few female pharaohs. We also see the massive Colossi of Memnon, two 64-foot-high statues of Amenhotep III that once guarded the gates of his mortuary temple. *B,L,D*

Day 11: Luxor We have the choice to rise early to see the West Bank from above on a hot air balloon ride. We disembark our ship later this morning and tour

Luxor Museum, housing relics discovered at the site. After lunch together, we transfer to our hotel. Dinner tonight is on our own. *B,L*

Day 12: Luxor/Cairo We fly to Cairo today, where we visit Khan el-khalili bazaar, the 700-year-old *souk*, one of the largest such markets in the world. This evening we enjoy a Dartmouth-sponsored reception at the Hyatt hotel, meeting and mingling with local Dartmouth alumni of Egypt. *B,D*

Day 13: Cairo This morning we encounter the astounding Pyramids of Giza, the wonders of antiquity that have drawn visitors for millennia. Here, too, we see the enigmatic Sphinx, whose leonine body and human face were carved from a single piece of limestone. Then we have lunch at a local restaurant and this afternoon tour Old Cairo, where we visit 5th century St. Sergius Church, the Coptic church of el-Muallaqa, and the famed Ben Ezra Synagogue where, according to legend, baby Moses was found floating on the Nile some 3,300 years ago. *B,L*

Day 14: Cairo Today’s touring begins at the necropolis at Sakkara. Then we tour the Citadel of Saladin, housing the alabaster Mosque of Muhammad Ali. Tonight we enjoy a farewell dinner. *B,L,D*

Day 15: Depart for U.S. Very early this morning we transfer to the airport for our return flight to the U.S. *B*

Dartmouth Faculty Host



Susan Ackerman is the Preston H. Kelsey Professor in Religion, emerita at Dartmouth College. She joined the Religion Department in 1990 after teaching at the University of Arizona and at Winthrop College in South

Carolina and retired in 2024. She is a specialist in the religion of ancient Israel and the religions of Israel’s neighbors (Mesopotamia, Egypt, and Canaan), an interest she first developed as an undergraduate religion major at Dartmouth (A.B., 1980) and continued to explore in graduate school at Harvard (M.T.S., 1982; Ph.D., 1987). She is also the recipient of the Robert A. Fish 1918 Memorial Prize, awarded to a newly retired faculty member to commemorate a career of contributions to undergraduate teaching (2024); the Dean of the Faculty Award for Exceptional Service (2023); the Elizabeth Howland Hand-Otis Norton Pierce Award, for a Faculty Member Who Is an Outstanding Teacher of Undergraduates (2017); the Dean of the Faculty Award for Outstanding Mentoring and Advising (2009); and the Class of 1962 Junior Faculty Fellowship, awarded to a junior faculty member with excellence in teaching and promise as a scholar (1994).
