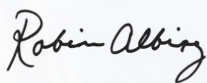

Featuring Faculty Host Frank J. Magilligan



Frank J. Magilligan is the Frank J. Reagan '09 Chair of Policy Studies, Professor of Geography and Adjunct Professor of Earth Sciences at Dartmouth College. Prof. Magilligan's teaching and research interests focus primarily on the biophysical and social aspects of watershed management. In particular, his research addresses stream channel and watershed response to environmental change – whether that change is generated by nature (e.g. climate change) or anthropogenic (e.g. agriculture, grazing, or logging) causes. Currently he is focused on the links between channel processes and riparian ecology, especially the role of dams – and their subsequent removal – on aquatic and floodplain ecological integrity. He received a Guggenheim Award to expand this work to examine the intersection of science and politics of river restoration in the United States. He has conducted international field work in the Peruvian Atacama Desert investigating the long-term evolution of El Nino floods and the regional relationship between climate change and cultural history.

Mysteries of Peru and Machu Picchu | Itinerary Highlights *(subject to change)*

Day 1 **EN ROUTE FROM U.S. • ARRIVE IN LIMA, PERU (D)** Upon arrival to Lima's Jorge Chávez International Airport an Orbridge representative will be waiting to assist with your transfer to the hotel. Take time to relax before gathering with fellow travel companions this evening at an iconic restaurant within a 300-year-old colonial mansion for a special welcome dinner.
Overnight: Pullman Lima Miraflores

Day 2 **LIMA (B,L)** Enjoy a guided city tour and market visit plus a cooking class to learn the tips and techniques of crafting traditional Peruvian dishes and the refreshing pisco sour cocktail. Have a mid-day lunch featuring traditional Peruvian cuisine at a local restaurant. Later explore the collection of ceramics, fabrics and precious metals at the Larco Museum.
Overnight: Pullman Lima Miraflores

Day 3 **LIMA • FLIGHT TO CUSCO • SACRED VALLEY (B,L)** After breakfast return to the airport for the brief flight to Cusco. Arriving at Alejandro Velasco Astete International Airport, board a motor coach for the approximate 90-minute drive to Yucay, stopping for lunch en route with fantastic photography opportunities of panoramic views over the Sacred Valley. Continue to the Yucay Museum of Living Culture for a guided visit. The rest of the day is at leisure.
Overnight: Sonesta Posada Yucay

Day 4 **SACRED VALLEY • MACHU PICCHU • CUSCO (B,L)** Early this morning depart for the Ollantaytambo train station to board the *Vistadome* train to Aguas Calientes. The journey through breathtaking landscapes is a treat in itself, with panoramic windows framing nature's grandeur. Disembark the train for a bus ride up the mountain. Lunch will be at the Machu Picchu Sanctuary Lodge followed by guided exploration of the ruins. Later return to Cusco via the *Vistadome* train.
Overnight: Aranwa Cusco Boutique Hotel

Day 5 **CUSCO (B,L)** Set out on a city tour to discover the archaeological sites of Sacsayhuamán and Qorikancha (Temple of the Sun). Next visit a local artisan chocolate shop for an engaging tour and tasting. Lunch is at Villa Tipón featuring a traditional Pachamama ceremony (offering to the Earth) and music performance.
Overnight: Aranwa Cusco Boutique Hotel



Day 6 **CUSCO • FLIGHT TO LIMA • PARACAS (B,L)** Following breakfast and the return flight to Lima, take the approximate 3.5-hour drive to the coastal town of Paracas. Check into your hotel and unwind before rejoining the group for a presentation on the Nazca Lines and pre-Incan history and cultures. The remainder of the day and evening are at leisure to enjoy the luxurious hotel amenities.
Overnight: La Hacienda Bahía Paracas

Day 7 **PARACAS (B,D)** This morning features an optional excursion to fly over the Nazca Lines—a UNESCO World Heritage Site—during a 90-minute aerial tour. Dating back to the Nazca culture which flourished between 200 BCE and 600 CE, these enormous geoglyphs can only be fully appreciated from above. Later set off towards Ica for an exciting open-air dune buggy adventure through the sand dunes including a visit to a winery followed by a beautiful sunset picnic dinner.
Overnight: La Hacienda Bahía Paracas

Day 8 **PARACAS • BALLESTAS ISLANDS (B)** Depart for a morning of discovery during a relaxing boat ride around the Ballestas Islands, a haven for avian life including penguins, petrels, boobies, cormorants and American oystercatchers. See the Paracas Candelabra, a massive geoglyph etched into the northern face of the Paracas Peninsula. The remainder of the afternoon and evening are at leisure at the property. Perhaps play a round of tennis, or paddleboard or kayak off the beach.
Overnight: La Hacienda Bahía Paracas

Day 9 **PARACAS • LIMA • DEPART FOR U.S. (B)** After breakfast depart for Lima where a group hospitality room will be provided at the hotel before transferring to the airport for departing flights home this evening. Guests continuing on the post-tour will fly from Lima to Iquitos. Hospitality Room: Wyndham Grand Costa del Sol
(B = Breakfast, L = Lunch, D = Dinner)

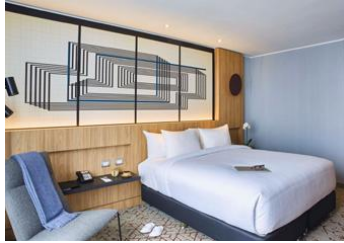

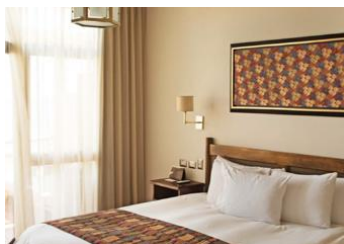
ARANWA CUSCO BOUTIQUE HOTEL

Day 9 **IQUITOS • AMAZON (L,D)** Upon arriving to Francisco Secada Vignetta International Airport a guide will assist with your transfer to the boat that brings you to Ceiba Tops Lodge. Before dinner take time to settle into your accommodations and perhaps explore the property's elaborate gardens or relax in the lounge.
Overnight: Ceiba Tops Lodge

Day 10 **AMAZON (B,L,D)** After breakfast join a skilled guide on a birding expedition to spot for the wildly diverse avian species in the area. Embrace the beauty of this vibrant forest as you listen to the melodious symphony of its inhabitants. Later venture into the heart of the rainforest on the Bushmaster Trail, a hiking experience that takes you through various ecosystems. A visit to a Yagua Indian Village highlights the living traditions of indigenous communities. End the day's adventures with a scenic trail walk before returning to the lodge for dinner.
Overnight: Ceiba Tops Lodge

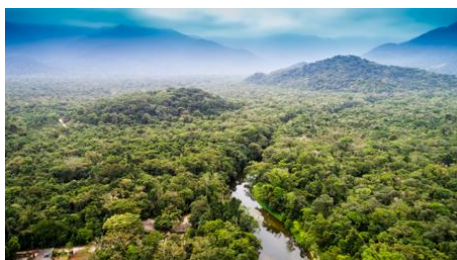
Day 11 **AMAZON (B,L,D)** Embark upon a scenic boat ride on the Amazon River to reach the Explornapo Lodge amidst the Sucusari Reserve. Take an exhilarating canopy walk through the forest. Afterward explore the fascinating local flora and their traditional uses during an ethnobotanical garden tour.
Overnight: Ceiba Tops Lodge

Day 12 **AMAZON • IQUITOS • LIMA (B,L)** Set out for a final hike along the river. Return to Iquitos by boat, then transfer to the airport for the return flight to Lima.
Overnight: Wyndham Grand Costa del Sol

Day 13 **LIMA • DEPART FOR U.S. (B)** Guests departing during the suggested times take the complimentary transfer to the airport for flights home.
