



 - a) Save-the-Date postcard in June 2023
 - b) 3 Newsletters with Reunion content (save the date; schedule, encouraging attendance; details)
 - c) Frequent FB posts
 - d) Guest columns in DAM
 - e) All class Email series highlighting various classmates and why they were coming to Reunion
 - f) Collected an early "likely list" followed up with personal emails
 - g) "Participation Captains"- Committee members and classmates sent personal emails to a groups of classmates
- 4. Created a Reunion specific website- hype video, FAQ's, likely list, schedule









