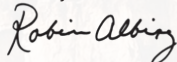

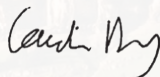
After each inspiring day, relax amidst well-appointed properties including three nights at the four-star Rimrock Resort Hotel in Banff.

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Featuring Faculty Hosts Robert Bonner and Leslie Butler



Robert Bonner '68a, the Kathie Tappe Vernon Professor in Biography and Professor in the History Department since 2009, researches and teaches primarily on nineteenth-century North American history. An expert on the 1860s crisis of Union and emancipation, among his books are *Mastering America: Southern Slaveholders and the Crisis of American Nationhood* and *The First Pariah State: How the Proslavery Confederacy Menaced the World*.

Leslie Butler, Professor of History and Vice Chair of the department, studies and teaches courses on American cultural and intellectual history that explore the contours and complexities of 19th-century Anglo-American liberalism. Her first book, *Critical Americans: Victorian Intellectuals and Transatlantic Liberal Reform*, examines a group of liberal intellectuals of the time who sought to remake public life, and her most recent book *Consistent Democracy: The "Woman Question" and Self-Government in Nineteenth Century America* explores debates on how women's roles in society shaped 19th-century political thought.

Canadian Rockies by Rail | Itinerary Highlights *(subject to change)*

Day 1 **EN ROUTE FROM U.S. | ARRIVE IN VANCOUVER, BRITISH COLUMBIA, CANADA (R)** Upon arrival an Orbridge representative will be waiting to assist with your transfer to the hotel. As with many Fairmont properties, the Fairmont Hotel Vancouver carries a rich historical legacy having welcomed dignitaries and celebrities since its opening in 1939. After settling into your room gather with fellow travelers for a special welcome reception.

Day 2 **VANCOUVER (B)** After breakfast set out for guided touring of Vancouver including Stanley Park, Kitsilano, the scenic views from the Spanish Banks, and the University of British Columbia. The remainder of the day is yours to explore Granville Island at leisure. This inviting oasis was once an industrial manufacturing area that transformed into a thriving marketplace and cultural district. Wander the colorful aisles at Public Market to discover an array of fresh produce, artisanal foods, international delicacies and local crafts. Visit a myriad of studios and galleries to witness skilled artisans at work, creating everything from handcrafted jewelry and ceramics to glass art and textiles. With its location along False Creek, Granville Island provides picturesque waterfront views. The maritime ambiance adds an extra layer of charm to the island experience. Enjoy a meal by the waterfront or opt for a quick bite from one of the food stalls for a true taste of local flavors.
Overnight: Fairmont Hotel Vancouver

Day 3 **VANCOUVER | ROCKY MOUNTAINEER | KAMLOOPS (B,L)** After an early morning check-out transfer to Rocky Mountaineer Station to board the *Rocky Mountaineer*. Freshly baked scones and a celebratory beverage will be served to toast the beginning of your rail adventure. As the train glides through ever-changing landscapes settle into plush reclining seats and admire the panoramas passing by. Following a delicious hand-crafted lunch return to the dome car to listen to expert commentary to gain a deeper understanding of the region's history and natural wonders. Arriving to Kamloops disembark the train for dinner on your own.
Overnight: Kamloops Lodging

Day 4 **KAMLOOPS | ROCKY MOUNTAINEER | BANFF, ALBERTA (B,L)** Climb back aboard the *Rocky Mountaineer* heading east to Banff. Enjoy a lovely breakfast, then step onto the outdoor viewing platform to capture photographs of the enigmatic landscape. Today's highlights include Craigellachie—where the last spike of the Canadian Pacific Railway was driven, the climb over Rogers Pass, the Spiral Tunnels, Kicking Horse Canyon and the glaciers and snow-capped peaks of the Canadian Rockies. Your engineers and onboard hosts will be on the lookout for wildlife—animals often spotted include grizzly and black bears, bighorn sheep, mountain goats, elk and eagles. The rail journey concludes in Banff where you'll disembark and transfer to your mountain retreat for an immersive experience amidst the Rockies.
Overnight: The Rimrock Resort Hotel

Day 5 **BANFF (B)** Ascend to the summit of Sulphur Mountain during a scenic gondola ride. Each fully enclosed four-passenger gondola cabin provides endless views of six magnificent mountain ranges, the Bow Valley and the town of Banff. At the top visit the interactive interpretive center and the Sulphur Mountain Boardwalk. Returning to the base of the mountain by gondola enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure.

Day 6 **BANFF | LAKE LOUISE | MORAINÉ LAKE (B,L,D)** This morning set out on a picturesque excursion to renowned Lake Louise—a pristine setting world famous for its turquoise lake and marvelous glacier peaks. Walk along the shoreline before entering the iconic Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise for a delicious lunch. Continue to Moraine Lake in the rugged Valley of the Ten Peaks, another postcard-perfect setting ideal for photography enthusiasts. This evening rejoin fellow travel companions for a special farewell dinner to reflect upon your Canadian rail adventure.
Overnight: The Rimrock Resort Hotel

Day 7 **BANFF | CALGARY | DEPART FOR U.S. (B)** After breakfast guests departing during the suggested time take the complimentary group transfer to Calgary International Airport for flights home.

(B = Breakfast, L = Lunch, D = Dinner, R = Reception)



Activity Level: Guests should be comfortable boarding and disembarking trains without assistance, walking and moving between coaches while the train is in motion and navigating stairs to upper level of the coach. Guests should also be able to enjoy outdoor walking with sure-footing on uneven terrain, get in and out of a motor coach without assistance, and be able to manage stairs.

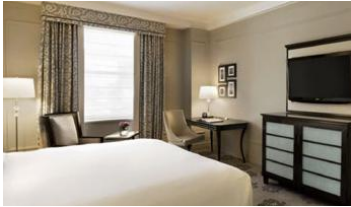

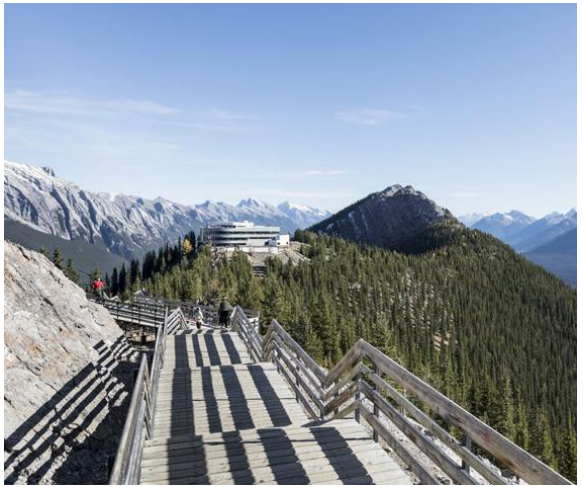

VICTORIA | VANCOUVER | MAIN PROGRAM BEGINS (B) Following breakfast meet your guide for a panoramic tour past the Parliament Buildings. Continue to world-famous Butchart Gardens—a national historic site of Canada replete with lush greens and colorful blooms. Blossoming for more than 100 years, it offers 55 acres of gardens with 900 bedding plant varieties, 26 greenhouses, and 50 full-time gardeners who create a wonderland of beauty everywhere you look. Afterward take a short ride to the ferry terminal for the 90-minute cruise over to mainland Vancouver. Upon arrival transfer to the hotel for a welcome reception to connect with fellow travelers joining the main program.
