# *Why Mini-Reunions Matter*

## *Strengthen Bonds*

Keep the connection with classmates beyond major reunion years.

## *Build Enthusiasm*

Create new memories and remind folks of the lifetime community they are a part of.

## *Reconnect and welcome new folks*

Staying engaged builds affinity for the class and school. This can also help develop your volunteer pipeline.



# *Ideation to Execution*

## *Purpose*

Celebrate a milestone, explore a new city, or gather at a bar to watch a Dartmouth sports event.

## *Scale*

A small group of close friends, a regional group, or your entire graduating class. Consider inviting a Reunion cluster!

## *Theme*

Will there be a specific focus – a sport, a cause, a decade's memories? Keep it simple!



## *A small & mighty execution team*

Share the load with your committee to support communications, logistics, and setup. Get buy-in!

# Considerations

## *Timing*

Give people enough time for a larger event, but be spontaneous and leverage Dartmouth or larger sporting events!

## *Budgeting*

Calculate participant fees and what the class treasury can support. Show the value proposition of dues fees.

## *Technology*


Canva, Encompass, Zoom...and AI. How will people hear about it, sign up for it and access your event.

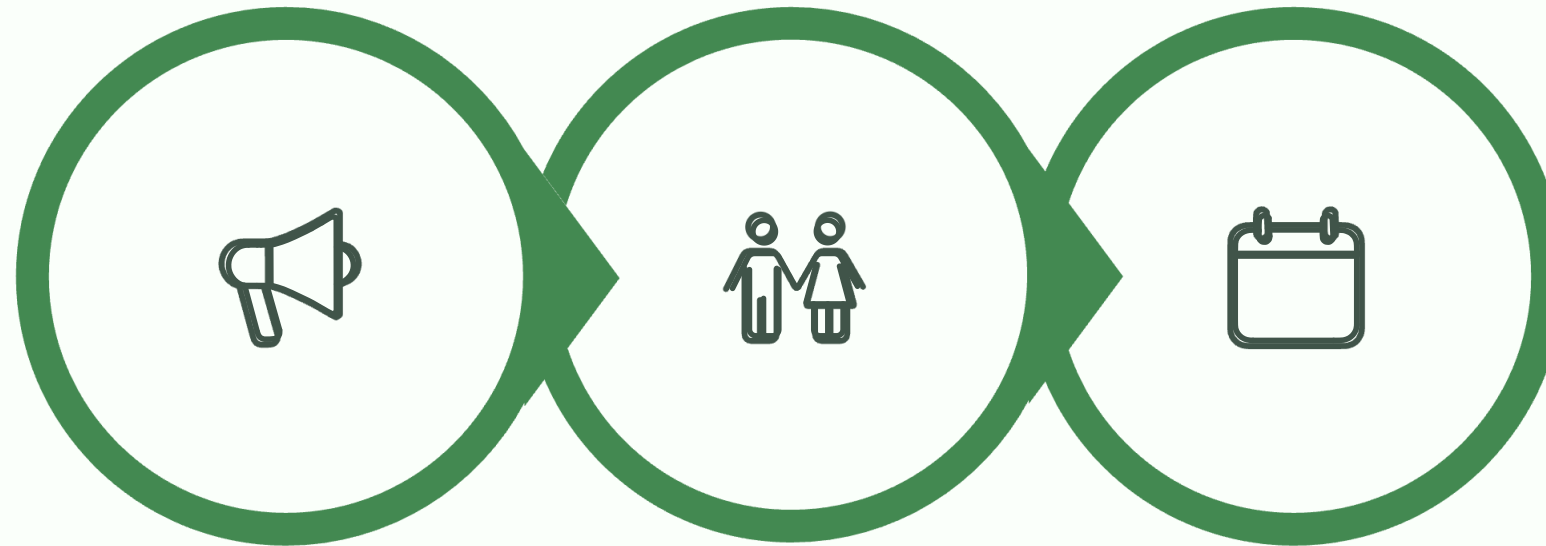
