## **Head and Assistant Workers**

Head Worker

• One head worker will be assigned to each class. We try to hire only head workers who have prior reunion experience.

• Cost includes wage, training, driver certification,

- Workers will manage your reunion registration, check event venue setups, run class errands and perform other duties as assigned.
- The head worker will schedule and oversee assistant workers.
- The number of assistant workers varies by class and is determined by class size and reunion program.
- Head and assistant workers may be under 21 years of age.
- All workers will be assigned in spring.
- Number of workers assigned are subject to change depending on projected attendance numbers.

Assistant Worker Tips	$\approx$ \$150-\$200 (per assistant worker)	<ul> <li>Actual tips depend on your level of satisfaction with assistant worker(s).</li> <li>The tip should be distributed to each worker individually (in cash) on the final day of the reunion.</li> </ul>

## **Head and Assistant Bartenders**

- One head bartender will be assigned to each class.
- All bartenders will be 21+ years of age and trained to serve alcohol according to NH state laws and within the guidelines of the College.
- Approximately 2-3 bartenders will be hired for every 150 people (depending on age of alumni group).
- Bartenders will set up the bar(s) before the event, serve for the duration of the event, and tear down at the end of each shift.
- On site, bartenders will work to ensure you have enough ice to chill the beverages being served. Reunion Chairs will work with Advancement Events in the spring to determine ice needs.
- Each class is still responsible for purchasing their own alcohol and supplies.
- All bartenders will be assigned in spring.
- Number of bartenders assigned are subject to change depending on projected attendance numbers.

Head Bartender Tips	≈ <b>\$275-</b> \$325	<ul> <li>Head bartender tips are generally based on the size/complexity of bar set up, and the number of guests at events.</li> <li>The tip should be distributed to each worker individually (in cash) on the final day of the reunion.</li> </ul>
Assistant Bartender(s)	50 <sup>th</sup> , 25 <sup>th</sup> - <b>\$610</b> 55 <sup>th</sup> , 60 <sup>th</sup> , 30 <sup>th</sup> - <b>\$560</b> 5 <sup>th</sup> - 20 <sup>th</sup> , 35 <sup>th</sup> - 45 <sup>th</sup> - <b>\$425</b> (per assistant bartender)	<ul> <li>2 bartenders for 35<sup>th</sup> - 45<sup>th</sup>, 55<sup>th</sup>, and 60<sup>th</sup>.</li> <li>3 bartenders for 10<sup>th</sup> - 20<sup>th</sup>, and 30<sup>th</sup>.</li> <li>5 bartenders for 5<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup> and 50<sup>th</sup>.</li> <li>6 bartenders for 25<sup>th</sup> and 50<sup>th</sup>.</li> <li>Cost is per bartender and includes training, certification, meals and housing.</li> <li>Cost covers bartending service for all reunion dinners.</li> <li>This charge will be included in the final College invoice; student wages are paid through the College.</li> </ul>
Assistant Bartender Tips	$\approx$ \$200-\$250 (per assistant bartender)	<ul> <li>Bartender tips are generally based on the size/complexity of bar set up and number of guests at events.</li> <li>The tip should be distributed to each worker individually (in cash) on the final day of the reunion.</li> </ul>
