Head and Assistant Workers, Head and Assistant Bartenders

Head and Assistant Workers

- **One head worker will be assigned to each class.** We try to hire only head workers who have prior reunion experience.
- Workers will manage your reunion registration, check event venue setups, run class errands and perform other duties as assigned.
- The head worker will schedule and oversee assistant workers.
- The number of assistant workers varies by class and is determined by class size and reunion program.
- Head and assistant workers may be under 21 years of age.
- All workers will be assigned in spring.
- Number of workers assigned are subject to change depending on projected attendance numbers.

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| Assistant Worker(s) | 50 th , 25 th - \$970 55 th , 60 th , 30 th - \$725 5 th - 20 th , 35 th - 45 th - \$630 (per assistant worker) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ 2 assistant workers for 10th – 20th, and 30th – 45th, 55th, 60th, ▪ 3 assistant workers for 5th. ▪ 4 assistant workers for 50th and 25th. ▪ Cost is per assistant worker and includes wage, training, certification, meals and housing for your assistant workers. ▪ This charge will be included in the final College invoice; student wages are paid through the College. |
| Assistant Worker Tips | ≈ \$150-\$200 (per assistant worker) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Actual tips depend on your level of satisfaction with assistant worker(s). ▪ The tip should be distributed to each worker individually (in cash) on the final day of the reunion. |

Head and Assistant Bartenders

- **One head bartender will be assigned to each class.**
- All bartenders will be 21+ years of age and trained to serve alcohol according to NH state laws and within the guidelines of the College.
- Approximately 2-3 bartenders will be hired for every 150 people (depending on age of alumni group).
- Bartenders will set up the bar(s) before the event, serve for the duration of the event, and tear down at the end of each shift.
- On site, bartenders will work to ensure you have enough ice to chill the beverages being served. Reunion Chairs will work with Advancement Events in the spring to determine ice needs.
- **Each class is still responsible for purchasing their own alcohol and supplies.**
- All bartenders will be assigned in spring.
- Number of bartenders assigned are subject to change depending on projected attendance numbers.

| Head Bartender Tips | <p>≈ \$275-\$325</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Head bartender tips are generally based on the size/complexity of bar set up, and the number of guests at events. ▪ The tip should be distributed to each worker individually (in cash) on the final day of the reunion. |
| Assistant Bartender(s) | <p>50th, 25th - \$610 55th, 60th, 30th - \$560 5th - 20th, 35th - 45th - \$425 (per assistant bartender)</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ 2 bartenders for 35th - 45th, 55th, and 60th. ▪ 3 bartenders for 10th - 20th, and 30th. ▪ 5 bartenders for 5th, 25th and 50th. ▪ 6 bartenders for 25th and 50th. ▪ Cost is per bartender and includes training, certification, meals and housing. ▪ Cost covers bartending service for all reunion dinners. ▪ This charge will be included in the final College invoice; student wages are paid through the College. |
| Assistant Bartender Tips | <p>≈ \$200-\$250 (per assistant bartender)</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Bartender tips are generally based on the size/complexity of bar set up and number of guests at events. ▪ The tip should be distributed to each worker individually (in cash) on the final day of the reunion. |
