

Day 1 | In Transit

Depart your gateway city for Paris, France.

Day 2 | Paris, France

Upon arrival, transfer **Э** and embark your ship. Settle in your comfortable cabin and get acquainted with the ship's modern amenities.

Later, gather with new friends for a Welcome Reception and Dinner. Then bid farewell to Paris as the ship departs for your Seine River cruise!

Day 3 | Versailles | Conflans-Sainte-Honorine

Versailles Discovery. Travel to France's grandest palace. Versailles was France's political capital and seat of the royal court from 1682-1789. See the opulent rooms, sprawling gardens and the famous Hall of Mirrors. The Treaty of Versailles, which ended World War I, was signed in the famous Hall of Mirrors.

Conflans-Sainte-Honorine. Enjoy a guided walk in this colorful town, located at the confluence of the Seine and Oise Rivers.

Day 4 | Jumièges | Rouen

Ancient Abbeys. Venture through the French countryside to visit the ruins of the Benedictine Abbey of Jumièges, one of the most powerful abbeys in medieval France. The ruins of the current building are from the 11th century, but the original monastery was built 300 years earlier. See the abbey's cloisters and the remains of the Église St Pierre. Continue to Abbey Saint-Wandrille, recognized as one of Normandy's first Benedictine abbeys. The buildings, which flaunt rococo-style and Gothic decorations, still house a monastic community.

Rouen. Embark on a walking tour of historic Rouen. The medieval quarter is filled with

ornate Gothic churches and half-timbered houses. Witness Notre-Dame de Rouen, the city's grand cathedral captured so brilliantly in paintings by Claude Monet. Marvel at Le Gros-Horloge, the famous astronomical clock. Along the way, listen to tales of Joan of Arc. Back on board, enjoy a delicious dinner.

Day 5 | Le Havre | Étretat | Honfleur

Étretat. The grand white cliffs and arches along Étretat's coastline are represented in nearly 80 works of art by Monet. Take a gentle stroll along a cliff-top path, enjoying views before you.

PYJ | Choose one of these excursions:

- *Calvados Farm Tour.* Head to the country to visit a family-run cider farm. Tour the farm and learn about the production of pure fruit juices, Calvados and Pommeau, a delightful mixture of apple juice and apple brandy. Enjoy a sampling of these special items! (*Active*)
- *Musée d'art moderne André Malraux.* Join a tour of the MUMA, an art museum known for its collections by Renoir, Pissarro, Sisley, Degas and other wonderful artists.

Gardens at Versailles





• *Deauville.* Get to know this beautiful seaside resort located along the Côte Fleurie. Wander along the boardwalk, lined with elegant shops, hotels and golden-sand beaches.

Honfleur. Continue the day in the French port town that has captivated artists for centuries, including Monet, Gustave Courbet and Eugène Boudin. Soak up the ambience of its pictureperfect Vieux Bassin, or old harbor, located where the Seine River meets the English Channel. Stroll through the pretty harbor and along the narrow side streets to see the city's landmarks. The Church of Sainte-Cathérine is a special stand-out.

Enrichment: *Normandy's Culture, History & People*. Join a local expert to uncover the rich, fascinating history of the Normandy area.

Day 6 | Caen | D-Day Beaches | Caudebec-en-Caux

Normandy and D-Day. Begin a memorable



journey into World War II history at Pointe du Hoc. It was here that U.S. Rangers scaled 100-foot cliffs to destroy German artillery emplacements that posed a threat to troops landing on Omaha and Utah beaches. With your guide, learn more about this treacherous mission. Next, step foot on Omaha Beach and contemplate the bravery of the Allied landing forces who advanced under devastating fire across the heavily fortified shoreline to overcome German troops. Continue to Collevillesur-Mer to visit the Normandy American Cemetery. The cemetery overlooks Omaha Beach and contains 9,385 graves of Americans who died in the invasion and subsequent battles, as well as a garden honoring those missing in action. Finally, visit the moving Caen Peace Memorial Museum.

Day 7 | Les Andelys | Giverny | Vernon

Monet, His Life in Giverny. Delve into the life of impressionist Claude Monet at his Giverny home. Admire the Japanese garden, pond filled with lilies and green footbridge captured in his artistry. Visit the studio where he created his famous "Water Lilies" series and step into his home to admire the cheerful rooms painted in bright yellows and blues. Relax over lunch while sailing to Paris.

Day 8 | Paris

Gems of Paris. See the City of Light during a cruise on the Seine. Admire iconic landmarks, including the Louvre, and float under charming bridges. Continue on a walking tour through the heart of Paris. Along the way, see the famous Notre-Dame, and cross the Pont de l'Achevêché for a look at the Latin Quarter.

Free Time: The afternoon is at your leisure. Join a Farewell Reception and Dinner tonight.

Day 9 | In Transit

After breakfast, transfer **>** to the airport for the return flight **\$** to your gateway city.


