Over the past 24 Summers he has directed the Futures of American Studies Institute at Dartmouth.



Day 1| In Transit

Depart gateway city for Zürich, Switzerland.

Day 2 | Zürich, Switzerland | St. Moritz

Upon arrival, transfer **3** to St. Moritz and check in to the elegant Hotel Schweizerhof.

Day 3 | St. Moritz | Zuoz

St. Moritz & Zuoz Walking Tours. Enjoy walking tours that showcase these appealing destinations. Begin in the mountain resort of St. Moritz. Take in jaw-dropping mountain vistas, and glimpse daily life at local shops. Continue via train to Zuoz, an endearing Upper Engadine village. 
